

Percentage of pupils entering for the English Baccalaureate (EBacc)

To enter EBacc pupils must take up to 8 GCSEs or equvalents, across the five subject pillars of English Language, English Literature, Maths, Sciences, a language and History and Geography.

English Baccalaureate (EBacc) average point score (APS)

The EBacc APS calculates a pupil's average point scores across the 5 pillars of the English Baccalaureate, allocating points to a pupil's best grades and dividing by 6 (the science grades count in 2 pillars, meaning a total of 6 pillars) to create an average point score per pupil.
