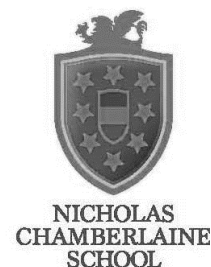

Dear NCS families

Please be aware of our new behaviour policy which is shortly to be published on our website.

Regarding mobile phones, the rule remains that these can be brought into school as long as they are switched off and in bags. If phones are taken out or used during the school day they will be confiscated. Reception will contact families at the end of the day and phones can be recovered by a parent or carer the next day. If a child breaks the rule again the phone will be confiscated and put in the school safe for a week. If a child continues to break the rule they will not be allowed to bring a phone into school. Mobile phones cause a real distraction to learning and can cause safeguarding issues in school.

We know this applies only to a tiny minority of students and we expect the highest standards of all.
