Year 11 update

We are extremely proud of how our Year 11 students have conducted themselves during practical and speaking exams. We are writing to update you on the comprehensive plans to support your child throughout the remainder of their GCSE Exams. Please see below for these details and the program of support:

Week beginning 6th May (exams begin this week)

Students will have exams, carefully planned booster sessions, registration and formally taught lessons. **All exams/sessions/lessons must be attended**.

Weeks beginning 13th and 20th May

Students will have exams, carefully planned booster sessions, and registration/ lessons. In lessons, students will have the freedom to revise the subjects they wish, while being supported and supervised by their teacher. **All exams/sessions/lessons must be attended.**

From week beginning 3rd June until the end of the examination period

Students will have exams and carefully planned booster sessions, which should all be attended. There will be supervised spaces at all times for students to revise should they wish to remain on-site; however, we appreciate that some students may benefit from revising at home. If they leave the school site, your child must be back in on time for their exams, we advising being on site at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start time. They must also sign in and out.

Support for students

We continue to work with students on preparing for their exams; tutors support students with exam revision timetables. They will have one of these each week, and we encourage you to ask to see this and to display it in a visible place at home. We will have specialised support services coming to talk to students about managing exam stress, and we regularly remind them of the support available in school. Exam attendance

Please be aware that unless you child has a doctors note, they must attend a formal examination. If they are ill on the day of their exam, please let reception/Ms Darly know so that we can support them. Failure to attend an exam on a child's printed timetable without a Dr's note would result in the exam fee (between \pounds 50-70 per paper) being invoiced back to the child's parents/guardians. If your child is late to an exam, we must inform the exam board and the awarding body may not accept their script.

Farewell celebrations in school

We will bid farewell to students on 28th June from 9:00 am to 11:00 am when examinations have finished. We welcome all students to celebrate, and say farewells and sign shirts/books. We welcome any uniform donations on this day so that we can support other families.
