Dear Year 11 NCS Families,

The next round of trial exams is due to take place starting on Monday 14th November. In preparation for this we wanted to share with you the schedule to fully prepare your child for these important assessments.

Trial exams give students the opportunity to experience the examination process in readiness for their official exams in June so it's imperative that your child attends school to participate in these, providing us with data to best support your child's academic progress.

Exams start promptly at 9am each morning, so arriving at school at 8:40am is imperative. This ensures plenty of time to settle in the exam hall and to be registered. If a student does not attend a trial exam for any reason then a re-sit session will be arranged for after school.

When we complete the official examinations, students who miss examinations without written medical evidence will be charged for the qualification and no grade will be awarded. The exam board also has the right to refuse entry for students arriving late once the exam has started.

Students should wear full uniform, have the correct equipment in a clear pencil case, and have a clear drinks bottle.

Where an exam finishes on or after 3pm, students will be allowed to leave early.

Results will then be available for collection on Thursday 15th December, which coincides with Year 11 Parents' Evening.

Trial exam information

The second round of trial exams start on **Monday 14th November** and finish on **25**th **November**. It's important that students bring correct equipment to the exams as <u>no</u> <u>equipment will be given out.</u>

- Maths equipment- protractor/compass

To help with revision we would recommend the following

- 2. Blank revision/flash cards
- 3. A4 ring binder with dividers to store notes. You can get a large one or several for each subject.
- 4. A4 wallet for exam papers
- 5. Notebook
- 6. Post-its
- 7. Diary or use phone to add in all key dates for exams, revision sessions etc during Year 11
