EYFS – Reception Summer 1 – 2022 – What Can You See In Summer?



Literacy

The stories we will focus on are:

What The Ladybird Heard, Caterpillar Spring, Butterfly Summer, and Summer Poems.

We will be learning to:

- Anticipate key events in stories.
- Read words consistent with their phonic knowledge by sound-blending.
- Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with a letter or letters.

How can I help at home?

- Practice reading together at home.
- Practice writing letters, cards, and stories.

Communication and Language

This half term we will be learning to:

- Discuss what might happen next in stories.
- Use full sentences.
- Use past, present and future tenses.

How can I help at home?

- Have conversations with lots of questions.
- Discuss opinions and interests together
- Model good speaking skills when conversing together correcting tenses where necessary.

Mathematics

This half term we will be learning to:

- Have a deep understanding of number to 10, including the composition of each number.
- Subitise up to 5.
- Automatically recall number bonds to 5 and some number bonds to 10, including double facts.

How can I help at home?

- Practice doubling numbers using objects.
- Practice forming numbers to 10.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will be learning to:

- Be confident trying new things
- Make good friendships
- Explain the reason for rules

How can I help at home?

- Discuss what is right and wrong in the household
- Try new challenges such as cooking, swimming, or cleaning.

Understanding the World

This half term we will be learning to:

- Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now.
- Know some similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country.
- Explain some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries.

Physical Development

This half term we will be learning to:

- Negotiate obstacles safely.
- Demonstrate strength, balance, and coordination
- Use small tools

How can you help at home?

- Spend time outside and active together
- Practice using a range of tools such as cutlery independently.

Trips/Experiences

Writing and delivering a letter at the local post box.

Learning about road safety crossing the roads.
