English

Physical Literacy

Tag Rugby

This Tag Rugby unit will teach year 3 players the skills needed to play both defensively and offensively as a tag rugby player.

The children will learn how to catch and throw while both stationary and on the move. They will develop skills of tagging and sidestepping as well as making tactical decisions about when to make passes and tags. They will also learn skills of finding a useful space and get into positions to support teammates.

Children will have the opportunity to play a mini tournament to put their newly developed skills into practice
